

Development Update...

Work continues behind the scenes on many town centre projects. We regularly meet with agents representing major property owners including the Royal Priors and House of Fraser, along with the Chief Executive of Warwick District Council.

We discuss a range of issues and opportunities including the treatment of vacant units, attracting new investment, waste management, mobility, parking, policing, markets and town centre development sites.

We are pleased to announce 'The Fold' - Spencer Street recently opened, and works on the Town Hall will commence soon so you will see hoarding. These are funded by the Future High Street Fund. In general, the curation and management of our town centre is dependent on strong relationships with key stakeholders and property owners. Please

Parking ... 2 Free Days

Two free days of 'OFF-Street' parking in Warwick District Council car parks are offered each year. These will be:

- Sunday 19th November -Christmas Light Switch-on
- 2. Saturday 2nd December -Small Business Saturday

Parking in 'south town' car parks is £3 all day - from 8am.

There is also FREE Parking all day Mon-Fri (7.30am - 7.30pm) at Warwick District Council, Riverside House (CV32 5HZ).

Lobby Efforts Continue

Last year BID Leamington, alongside other BIDs nationally, extensively lobbied the government for business rates relief - currently 75% (2023/24).

The challenges facing businesses and communities are still apparent, and we are concerned about the loss of this support in 2024, so our lobby efforts continue. We are working with our MP. Councils and BIDs nationally. Feedback is welcome.
